Filtered Internet wireless service is provided for use by Atrium Studio School staff members, students and guests only. Students, staff and guests are expected to act in a professional, responsible, ethical and legal manner when utilizing the Atrium Studio School Wireless Network.

Users must agree to the Atrium Studio School terms listed below:

1. Atrium Studio School makes no warranties of any kind, whether express or implied, for the network or technology services provided. The School is not responsible for any damages incurred including loss of data resulting from data delivery delays, missed deliveries, or financial obligations incurred through the use of Internet websites. Use of any information obtained through the Wireless Network is at the user's risk. The School disclaims responsibility for the accuracy or quality of information obtained through the Internet or other forms of electronic communication.
2. Atrium Studio School will not be held responsible for any physical damage, loss or theft of personal devices or for data loss. The School is not responsible for providing power to personal devices on the Wireless Network.
3. Atrium Studio Schools Wireless Network will provide filtered Internet access only. No access to internal-only School printers, servers or services is provided.
4. Atrium Studio School filters, logs and monitors access to the Internet and blocks offensive, obscene, and inappropriate images and content including pornography.
5. The School reserves the right to log, monitor and review all activities on the Atrium Studio Wireless Network.
6. Atrium Studio School reserves the right to inspect, at any time, any personally owned device while connected to the Wireless Network.
7. Student use of personal electronic devices in the classroom setting will be at the discretion of the classroom teacher and building principal.
8. Atrium Studio School does not provide technical support for staff, student or guest personal devices on the Atrium Studio School Wireless Network.
9. Illegal use of the Atrium Studio School Wireless Network, intentional deletion or damage to files or data belonging to others, copyright violations or theft of services may be reported to the appropriate legal authorities for possible prosecution.
10. Violation of any of the above terms or to the provisions in the Atrium Studio School. Acceptable and Responsible Use of Network Resources policy will result in the suspension or termination of a user's privilege to technology resources, a restriction of the users privileges and a withdraw of privileges to the Atrium Studio School Wireless Network. Staff and students should understand that if they commit any violation of this policy, their access privileges will be suspended or revoked, disciplinary action will be taken, and/or appropriate legal action may be instituted.
